Visual Guide to Official Washington State Proof of COVID-19 Vaccination

COVID-19 vaccination is required by many businesses, events and employers. The following types of proof are accepted in Washington. Some locations may only accept one specific type from this list below. **Respect the rules of the room and be prepared in advance to show the type of proof requested.**

CDC COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card



- Originals, copies or photographs on a mobile device are acceptable.
- Full vaccination is valid two weeks after last recorded dose:
 - Single dose for Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) vaccine.
 - Two doses of Pfizer-BioNTech/Comirnaty or Moderna vaccine.


Certificate of COVID-19 Vaccination or QR Codes

- Sample C: QR Code displayed on an endorsed partner mobile app. (Apps may vary)

- Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS) forms printed from the Washington State Immunization Information System.
- Hand-written entries are not considered valid unless signed by a medical provider.
